History

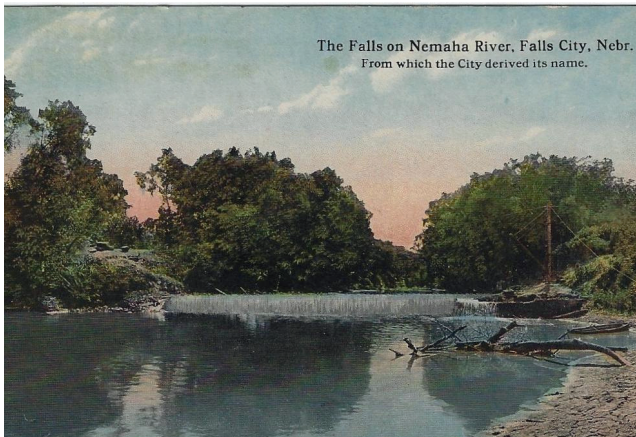
Founded in 1857, three years after the opening of the Nebraska Territory, "Falls City" was the Nebraska base on the "Lane Trail" through which free-state emigrants could be funneled into Kansas.

James Lane, a free-soil leader, was greatly impressed by the beauty of the Nemaha Valley and noted the rich soil. He also took note of the industrial possibilities which the falls of the river seemed to offer. Lane's expectations for "a city by the falls" has undergone more than a century of change, yet with a strong, sustained growth the city peaked at 6,200 residents in 1950, with a 2020 population of 4,130.

Early in 1900 Falls City developed as a poultry packing and dairy processing center. As the center of county business, it developed as a banking and financial hub for the area, and as an educational center.

Falls City's downtown was placed on the National Register of Historic Places and has a rich architectural heritage, with a number of historic buildings that are solid examples of late nineteenth and early twentieth century commercial vernacular architecture. In 2022 the corner of 16th & Stone Street was declared a Freedom Site on the Underground Railroad.
