Matching signs

Door painted light blue to match Sandstone Grill door

Window frames painted dark blue to match Sandstone Grill windows

Image 2a (left): Option 1. In order to visually connect the two buildings, three similar awnings in Sunbrella fabric "Toast" are used over the first floor windows and doors. The door and window frames on the Inn side are painted to match that of the Grill side. The old "Hotel" sign is replaced with new "Sandstone Inn" sign, which was created as a replica to the "Grill" sign using the same colors and font.

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- Sign lines up with the left edge of the Inn's windows.
- Awnings used for the upper story windows.
- Window frames painted dark blue to match Sandstone Grill windows
- Door painted light blue to match Sandstone Grill door



- Sign aligned with the left edge of the Inn's windows and the existing "Sandstone Grill" sign.
- Awnings used for the upper story windows.
- Window frames painted dark blue to match Sandstone Grill windows
- Door painted light blue to match Sandstone Grill door

Image 3a (left): Option 2. The same pattern of three awnings is used above the lower level windows as in Option 1. Awnings are added to the upper story windows. Awnings in Sunbrella fabric Gaston Jewel (4976). The door and window frames are painted as in Option 1. The same 3D letters are used for the new sign. It is aligned with the far left edge of the Inn building.

Image 3b (below): Awning Fabric. Gaston Jewel (4976).



Image 4a (left): Option 3. The same pattern of awnings is used on both stories as before. Awnings in Sunbrella fabric Mediterranean Blue Tweed (4653). The same painting of the door and window frames is used as in previous options. The 3D lettered sign is again aligned with the left side windows and is moved to the same level as the existing sign.

Image 4b (below): Awning Fabric. Mediterranean Blue Tweed (4653).



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- Signs mirror each other across building joint.
- Window frames painted dark blue to match Sandstone Grill windows
- Awnings used for the upper story windows.
- Door painted light blue to match Sandstone Grill door



- New sign painted in the inverse colors of existing sign. Signs mirror each other across building joint.
- Window frames painted dark blue to match Sandstone Grill windows
- Awnings used for the upper story windows.
- Door painted light blue to match Sandstone Grill door

Image 5a (left): Option 4. Awning pattern remains the same as previous options. Awnings in Sunbrella fabric Linen Tweed (4654). The door and window frames are painted as before. The new sign mimics the existing "Sandstone Grill" sign in color and font style. The new sign is aligned with the left edge of the windows and is on the same level as the existing "Grill" sign. The existing sign is aligned with the right edge of the Grill building's windows in order to mirror the position of the new sign.

Image 5b (below): Awning Fabric. Linen Tweed (4654).



Image 6a (left): Option 5. Same awning pattern used as before. Awnings in Sunbrella fabric Hartwell Fiesta (4973). Door and window frames painted as before. New sign is painted in colors which are the inverse of the existing sign. The same sort of mirror positioning is used for the two signs.
