


Image 2. This early 1900s historic photograph shows the G Street frontage of the Geneva State Bank building and the adjoining Geiselman Building and Brown Building, both now owned by the bank.



Image 3. This view of the existing condition of the block face on the north side of G Street shows the second Geneva State Bank building, erected in 1906, anchoring the northwest corner of the intersection of G and North 9th Streets, far right. The Geneva State Bank also owns the adjoining Geiselman Building and Brown Building. All of these buildings, dating to the late 19th century and early 20th century, are situated directly across G Street from the majestic 1893 Fillmore County Courthouse.




Image 4. The existing condition of the east facade of the three-story Geneva State Bank (left) and the adjoining one-story red brick Ashby Building to the north (right) is shown in this photograph. The first floor of the 1906 bank building was extensively remodeled on the interior and exterior in 1961 (compare with Images 1 and 2). The intricate detailing of the fanlights in the Ashby Building has been obliterated by white paint which covers the glass and muntins.



Image 5. The Geneva State Bank logo, taken from the bank's Web site, could be appliqued to the proposed awnings.



Image 6. The existing condition of the Geneva State Bank is shown in this corner view, looking northwest at the intersection of G and North 9th Streets. The effect of the 1961 first floor remodeling of the 1906 building is illustrated (compare with Image 1).






Image 12: "Terra Cotta" (style #4622) Sunbrella fabric sample

This option includes opening the fanlights in the Ashby Building (right). Also, the doors, window and door frames, and window muntins on the Ashby Building are painted to match the stone veneer on the main bank building.
