
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Image 1 (left). Existing facade condition.

The signage has been removed from the facade, and a new brickframed sign is placed near the entrance. The new garage door resembles the type of door that would have been installed in the building originally.






Image 5. Option 3. Facade adjustments are similar to Option 2. The door and awnings color is Sunbrella's "Black Cherry" (4640).



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
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


