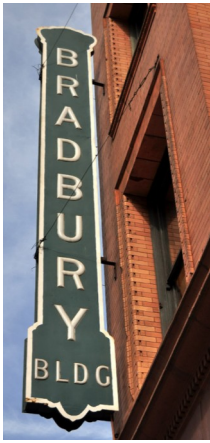


IDEA #1

VERTICAL CORNER PROJECTING BLADE SIGN

Matches what looks like was there previously at some point in the life of the building. It should be designed appropriate to scale (size and height) to the upper façade of the building with correct placement between the canopy and top of the building. Weight, expense and electricity for lighting will be important considerations. Avoid neon as that was not common in downtown Beatrice and is also risky due to the hail storms we have in Nebraska. See examples below for style and design ideas.



IDEA #2

VERTICAL FLAT MOUNTED CORNER SIGNS

These flat mounted vertical signs could be placed on the upper façade corners with one mounted on the south wall and the other mounted on the east wall. Just like as in idea #1, scale and placement are very important.



IDEA #3

HORIZONTAL FLAT MOUNTED CORNER SIGNS

The horizontal version of the vertical flat mounted corner signs in idea #2 but mounted just above the canopy.
